

Rule 5 / Case 5 Quiz

KEYS

Team A or Team B is designated as A or B

Team A or Team B's 45 yard-lines, example: A-45 or B-45

Player A or B's number is 40, example: A40 or B40

Second down and 6 yards to go for A at the B 23 yard-line, example: A, 2/6, B-23

The Kicking or Receiving teams are designated as K or R

Team K or Team R's 45 yard-lines, example: K-45 or R-45

Player K or R's number is 65, example: K65 or R65

Fourth down and 12 yards to go for K at the R 45 yard-line, example: K, 4/12, R-45

1. A, 4/2, the nose of the ball touching the B-20. The QB throws a pass toward an eligible receiver that is incomplete at the B-15. (5-3-3b) 1 point

Mark only one oval.

- B, 1/10, B-20
- B, 1/10, B-20 plus 11 inches
- A, 4-2, B-20

2. A, 3/6, A-40. The fullback runs around the right end to the A-44. During the tackle, a linebacker grabs the fullback's facemask and releases it as he falls to the ground. After the play, the fullback swears at the linebacker. (5-1-2) 1 point

Mark only one oval.

- A, 3/16, A-30. Both penalties are assessed
- A, 3/6, A-40. Penalties offset
- A, 1/10, A-34. Both penalties are assessed
- A, 4/12, A-34. Both penalties are assessed

3. A, 3/10, B-20. Runner is running around the right end when he is hit and fumbles at the B-24. A defensive player recovers the ball at the B-25 and attempts a backward pass to a teammate. A Team A player intercepts the pass and is tackled at the B-28. (5-3-1, 3-4-3) 1 point

Mark only one oval.

- A, 1/10, B-28. Clock starts on the ready
- A, 1/10, B-28. Clock starts on the snap
- A, 3/18, B-28. Clock starts on the ready
- A, 3/18, B-28. Clock starts on the snap

4. K, 3/9, K-10. A kicker quick-kicks from the K-5. The kick is short and muffed by a receiver at the K-25. The ball rolls into K's backfield, where a kicker falls on the ball at the K-8. (6-2-3; 5-1-3f) 1 point

Mark only one oval.

- R, 1/10, K-8
- K, 1/10, K-8
- K, 4/11, K-8

5. K, 4/10, K-23. K leads 21-20 with less than 2 minutes remaining in the game. 1 point
K8's punt is very short and R23 signals for and makes a fair catch at the K-40.
A chooses to snap from the right hash. During the next play, B12 interferes
with A88's attempt to catch a pass and B15 intercepts the ball at the B-28.

Mark only one oval.

- A, 1/10, B-25. A must snap from the right hash
- B, 1/10, B-28
- A, 1/10, B-25. A can choose to have the ball placed in the middle for a free kick to possibly score a field goal.

6. K, 4/10, K-23. A legal scrimmage kick is blocked and rolls to the K-28. A 1 point
receiver muffs the ball, which rolls to the K-20. A kicker picks up the ball and
punts it again, and the ball rolls out of bounds at the K-45. (5-1-3e, 6-2-1, 6-2-3)

Mark only one oval.

- R, 1/10, K-20. The ball is dead when K32 recovers it
- R, 1/10, K-15. Illegal kick and the ball is dead when K32 kicks it
- R, 1/10, K-45. K32's punt is legal
